TrueID Instructions



What is the TrueID identity verification process and how do I begin?

In Maryland, **TrueID** is used to verify a claimant's identity (a claimant is an individual who applies for UI benefits). You may be prompted to begin TrueID when you apply for UI benefits or update information in BEACON (beacon.labor.maryland.gov/). When prompted, select one of the options below:

- I will complete the TrueID process;
- I do not have a smartphone or tablet or I do not wish to complete the TrueID process online. You can complete TrueID in person at a designated American Job Center (listed at labor.maryland.gov/employment/ui-ajc-trueid.shtml).
- I want to **speak to a live agent**. An agent can only answer your questions about TrueID.

NOTE: If you: 1) do not make a selection when prompted; 2) make a selection, but do not move forward with TrueID within seven days (either by selecting the TrueID action item in BEACON or completing TrueID in-person); you will receive a determination (via your preferred communication method and BEACON) stating that you are not eligible for UI benefits. You may appeal the determination.

What do I need to complete TrueID?

You need a:

- driver's license/state-issued ID card (from any U.S. state) or passport book/passport card (from any country). IDs must be valid; and,
- smartphone or tablet that can take quality pictures; and,
- phone number or email address associated with the smartphone/tablet you use to take the picture.

How do I complete TrueID?

If you selected the "complete TrueID" option, you will receive a TrueID action item in BEACON.

- **Select the action item**, and provide an email address or phone number that can receive messages. A link will be sent to your smartphone or tablet by email or text.
- Select the link and follow the prompts to take a picture. You must take a picture of the front and back of your ID during the TruelD process.

How do I know if I passed TrueID?

- If you passed, you will receive a confirmation code on your smartphone/tablet. To complete TrueID, log in to BEACON within 48 hours and, when prompted, enter the confirmation code.
- If you do not pass, you will receive a notice on your smartphone/tablet. The Maryland Division of Unemployment Insurance (Division) will review your ID. You can also upload additional identity verification documents (within seven days of receiving the notice) in BEACON.

NOTE: If the Division determines that the ID is not acceptable, you will receive an appealable determination.
